

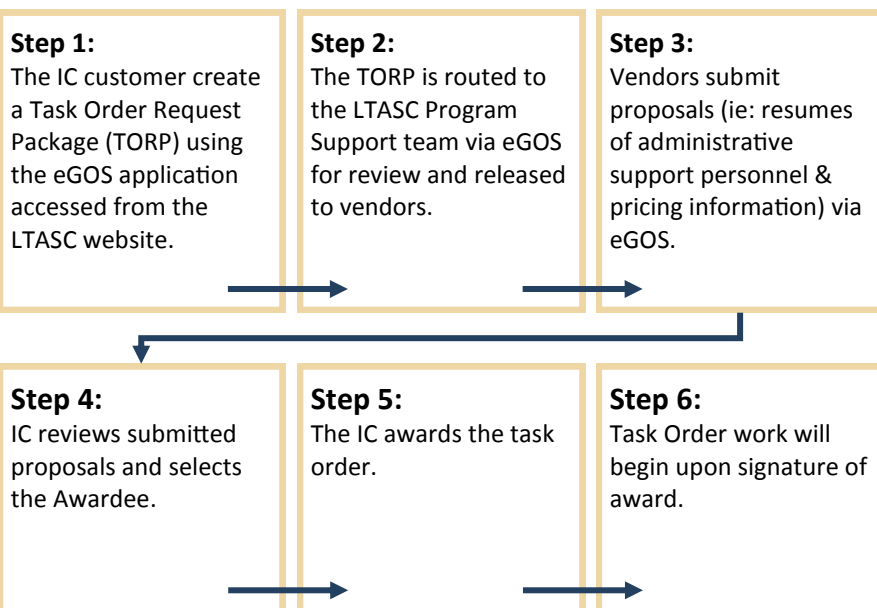

What it is:

- The second generation of a successful IDIQ contract used by National Institutes of Health (NIH)
- 5 year contract (1 base year + 4 option years) acquisition vehicle
- A tool to procure administrative services on a long-term basis of 12 months or more on a task order (TO) basis
- Utilized by NIH:
 - ◊ Institutes
 - ◊ Centers
 - ◊ Offices
